St. Mary's Tennis Club has three European clay courts and an extended clubhouse with changing facilities and a fully equipped kitchen. In addition, we offer table tennis, and have ample green space for our visitors to watch tennis, for parties or functions.

The real clay is affected by prolonged frosts, which can prevent play in the winter. However, there are real benefits: long rallies, good for all standards of play, kind to joints.

Playing at St. Mary's

Our 2023-24 adult membership is £195 from 1
April, with children under 18 and living at the same address, free. Additional adults at the same address: £55; students £105; juniors £50. A 'Chaperone' membership of £25 is available for an adult with a paying junior, enabling the adult to book courts and play with that junior only. There are no other charges, other than guest fees of £5 (a person is allowed to play up to 3 times in one subscription year)
