The Tennis Club is a part of the **charity "St Mary's Sports Ground".** This covers the tennis courts, the pavilion and grassed area and approximately half the field that goes down to the railway line. The other half of the field belongs to the Isleworthians.

The charity was set up in approximately 1928/29 following the gift of the land by Mr. Musgrave The charity's purpose is to make this available to the local community for recreation.

All members have access to the Sports Ground. They are also able to hire the pavilion and grassed area for small functions at reduced rates.

Guest fee: £10, adult; £2, child. A guest may play up to three times in a year. Members are responsible for paying this by BACS before going on court and emailing the guest's name to the club's email address
